APPENDIX - A
RULES FOR THE AWARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS TO
STUDENTS STUDING TRIBLE AREAS OF GUJARAT STATE

- Rule 1.** These scholarships shall be award by the Commissioner of Higher Education Commencement of every except Medical Course where the awards will be at the decided twice a year.
- Rule 2.** To be eligible for this scholarship student must be have secured atleast 50% marks at the S.S.C. Examination or the last University or College Examination on the result which the scholarship are awarded 20% of scholarship in each category of Higher Education Scholarship Scheme will be the marked for lady student reject, however, to the condition that marks obtained by suc lady student are not lower than 5% marks on obtained by the last student awarded a scholarship under the scheme.
- Rule 2-A** Full value of the scholarship will be awarded to children of parents/guarding whose income does not exceed Rs. 25,000 per annum Subject to the income limit specified above the award of scholarship should be decided on the basis of merits as assessed at the last examination.
- Rule 3.** An applicant receiving any other scholarship, stipends or financial assistance from Government or non-Government sources, other than freeship or half freeship by Government or non-Government Institutions will not ordinarily be considered eligible for the award of this Scholarship. Not withstanding the above an exception may be at the discretion of the Commissioner of Higher Education in case of a student who had been awarded a merit scholarships.
- Rule 4.** Scholarships once awarded will be continued from year to year will be duration of the course provided a student secures at least 50% marks in the annual examination However, the student shall be required to apply again as a fresh candidate when he proceeds from one course to another.
- Rule 5.** When a scholarship secures less than 50% marks in the promotional Examination, his scholarship will be suspended for one academic year. And will be reined on his attaining the requisite standard in the following annual examination. This concession will not be extended beyond one academic year for any particular stage of education scholarship will be discontinued if a student discontinued the studies in the middle of the Course.
- Rule 6.** If a student fails or is unable to appear in the annual examination due to prolonged illness and submits a medical certificate to that effect from the Civil Surgeon of the District concerned his case for renewal of scholarship will be considered by the Commissioner of Higher Edom if deemed fit.
- Rule 7.** The amount of scholarship will be paid in suitable installments as fixed by the Commissioner of Higher Education through the Principals of heads of the Institution.
- Rule 8.** Normally scholarship will not be awarded to the who are in full time employment. Those in the part-time employment, not exceeding two hours a day will however be eligible for considerate for the awards of these scholarships.

- Rule 9.** Student in receipt of this scholarship will not be permitted to change from one College to another without prior permission of Commissioner of Higher Education.
- Rule 10.** The application shall be invited by the Commissioner of Higher Education by a public advertisement before date to be specified by him. Candidates will be required to submit their applications in a prescribed form with necessary certificates and application duly signed by the Head of Institution to the Commissioner of Higher Education direct before the prescribed date. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
- Rule 11.** After the sanction of the scholarship or payment of any of the installment the Commissioner of Higher Education may cancel the scholarship if the progress of the student is not found to be satisfactory or if he is found guilty of misconduct. The decision of the Commissioner of Higher Education shall be final in the matter.
