8. Verification Procedure if any:

On receipt of application, the Registration Authority direct the Deputy Director, Dairy/Dairy Development Officer of the concerned district, to visit the place of the applicant for making inspection and submit his report within a period of fifteen days from the receipt of such direction, having regard to the following matters namely: -

- a) The details regarding machinery, equipment, staff and matter related to establishment of the units.
- b) The standard of raw material being used and of final product being distributed or sold and the provision made for its testing, if any.
- c) The system of implant quality control, and
- d) The method of final inspection, if any.

9. Prescribed Time Schedule-Activity wise:

- On receipt of application for registration from the applicant, the Registration Authority direct the Deputy Director, Dairy/Dairy Development Officer of the concerned district to send the inspection report of the unit within fifteen days.
- ii) The registration certificate is issued to the applicant within two months after completing all formalities.
- iii) An application for the renewal of registration certificate shall be made at least thirty days before the expiry of the term of the registration certificate.
- iv) The application of the renewal of registration certificate shall be disposed of within a period of one month from the date of receipt of application.
- v) If the application for renewal of registration certificate is not made within the period as specified, then the applicant can make an application for renewal along with late fee of fifty rupees within a period of one month after its expiry.
