2. The licensee shall also abide by the conditions laid down below:

(b) The licensee shall purchase, receive or acquire a trophy/ uncured trophy only from a dealer or from a person licensed or as the case may be, authorized to sell or otherwise transfer or hunt the same under the Act or the rules made there under.

(c) The licensee shall not purchase, receive, acquire or transport a trophy/uncured trophy in violation of the provisions of section 43 or section 48 of Act.

(d) The licensee shall do taxidermy only during business hours and at _____ premises. The place of business may be changed only with the prior permission of the authority that has issued this licence and where the place of business has been changed, the particulars of the new premises shall be entered in this licence. All trophies/uncured trophies shall be stored only at _____ premises.

(e) This licence shall be displayed at a conspicuous place of the premises in which the business of the licensee is carried on and shall be produced for inspection on demand being made by an officer appointed under sub-section (1) of section 4, or specified in subsection (1) of section 50, of the Act.
