CONDITIONS

- 1. The license is granted subject to all the provisions of the Arms Act, 1959 and of the Arms Rules, 1962.
- 2. The articles shall not be conveyed by any route other than that specified in column 8; and bulk shall not be broken, nor shall the consignment be stopped, before the articles reach the place of destination. Provided that where the consignment is ready but could not be despatched in one bulk, for reasons beyond the control of the licensee, the articles may be sent in lots, provided proper intimation is sent to the licensing authority, who may extend the time limit in column 11, if necessary.
- 3. An account of the contents of each package shall be legibly written thereon, and where the articles are conveyed by rail, each package shall be marked with the word "Arms" or "Ammunition" as the case may be, so as to be readily recognizable by the railway authorities.
- 4. The articles shall be delivered only to a person lawfully entitled to receive them.
- 5. Where a license granted for industrial purposes has been made valid for a period longer than the normal period of twice the time taken in journey from godown to factory [vide proviso to sub-rule(4) of Rule 38], necessary entries shall promptly be made in the stock registers maintained by the dealer for the purpose at both the palces (viz;godown and factory)
